2012 SEASONAL DEMONSTRATION GRANTS

Sullivan Renaissance will make a limited number of grants available to seasonal communities that will improve the appearance of their property as a demonstration for others. The maximum grant awarded will be **\$2500** and funding must be matched dollar for dollar, at a minimum. Eligible projects can include a wide range of activities such as fixing up entranceways and gates, planting flower gardens or other landscaping, removal of old structures and cleaning up dump sites, improving façades, replacing fencing or upgrading signage. Funds may also be used for professional services to develop landscaping plans. Improvements must be in areas visible to the public.

This is a reimbursement grant program. Sullivan Renaissance will reimburse applicants for half of the project cost, up to \$2500. Projects where the applicant match is greater than 50% will receive preference. A site visit with Sullivan Renaissance staff to help define the project is required before submitting an application.

Sullivan Renaissance supports projects that are sustainable and incorporate good environmental practices. Recipients must be aware of the materials they are using, the location of the project, and the use of invasive plants. Good garden design and practices are essential components, and each project must incorporate an appropriate choice of plant materials,

Completed grant applications must be submitted along with a photo of the area to be improved. Applications will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis through **August 6, 2012** based on funding availability. In addition to the grant, Sullivan Renaissance can provide assistance with choosing plant materials and/or obtaining a rendering or landscape plan.

Upon approval, you will receive an award letter and W-9 form. When the project is completed, applicants must return the signed W-9 form with “after photos” and receipts in order to receive reimbursement. All projects must be completed and documentation submitted no later than **October 15, 2012**. If you are unable to meet this deadline, you must contact Sullivan Renaissance for an extension before that date or the grant may be rescinded.
