



SULLIVAN RENAISSANCE 2010 MINI GRANTS

Through this program, a limited number of grants of up to \$200 are available for a group or entity that would like to participate at a “mini” level by planting a new garden, improving an existing landscape, removing debris and sprucing up or improving signage. Preference will be given to applicants that provide matching funds and/or services.

This is a reimbursement grant program. Applicants need to fill out the one page application on the reverse and provide a “before photo” of the area to be improved. If accepted, you will receive a confirmation letter and completion form. When the project is finished, return the completion form with an “after photo” and receipts for the supplies. When documentation is received, a check [not to exceed \$200] will be sent in the name of the initial applicant.

In addition to the grant, Sullivan Renaissance can provide assistance with choosing plant materials. A site visit will be conducted during the summer to provide feedback.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis starting **March 1, 2010**. Projects must be completed and photos submitted with receipts by **August 2, 2010**. Participants will be recognized at the annual Sullivan Renaissance Awards Ceremony on **August 9, 2010** at Monticello High School.
