2010 PROJECT MAINTENANCE GRANTS

Project Maintenance Grants are intended to give organizations a chance to regroup their community building efforts and maintain and enhance previous Sullivan Renaissance projects. Funding may be used to add or replace soil, mulch, plants, trees, shrubs and other landscape elements.

A limited number of Project Maintenance Grants of **up to \$750** will be awarded to help established groups maintain and enhance previously-funded projects. Groups that have completed at least two Sullivan Renaissance beautification projects within the past four years are eligible to apply. Groups may not receive two maintenance grants in a row. Funding is limited and will be awarded based on past participation.

Completed applications must be received with all accompanying documentation by **March 24, 2010**. Groups receive half the amount awarded as an initial grant at our Spring Forum on **April 15, 2010**. In addition, projects also receive **\$100** in Flower Dollars (which must be matched) to purchase annual plants from participating garden centers and nurseries.

Maintenance projects will receive site visits by Sullivan Renaissance staff and are eligible for a "Showing of Flowers" award. All projects must be completed and project documentation (copies of receipts and photographs) submitted to Sullivan Renaissance by **August 2, 2010**. After verification of receipts and Flower Dollar match, grantees will be reimbursed the balance of their grant in September.
