2010 SEASONAL DEMONSTRATION GRANTS

Sullivan Renaissance will make a limited number of grants available to seasonal communities that will improve the appearance of their property as a demonstration for others. The maximum grant awarded will be **\$2500** and funding must be matched dollar for dollar, at a minimum. Eligible projects can include a wide range of activities such as fixing up entranceways and gates, planting flower gardens or other landscaping, removal of old structures and cleaning up dump sites, replacing fencing or upgrading signage. Funds may also be used for professional services to develop landscaping plans. Improvements must be in areas visible to the public.

This is a reimbursement grant program. Sullivan Renaissance will reimburse applicants for half of the project cost, up to \$2500. Projects where the applicant match is greater than 50% will receive preference. A site visit with Sullivan Renaissance staff to help define the project is required before submitting the application.

Applicants need to fill out a one page application (see reverse) and provide a photo of the area to be improved. If accepted, a confirmation letter with instructions will be sent. When the project is completed, an “after photo” and receipts for the work must be submitted.

In addition to the grant, Sullivan Renaissance can provide assistance with choosing plant materials and/or obtaining a rendering or landscape plan.

Applications will be accepted beginning **March 1, 2010** and will be considered on a first come, first served basis through **July 30, 2010** based on funding availability. Projects must be completed and receipts and photos submitted no later than **August 28, 2010**. If you are unable to meet this deadline, you must contact Sullivan Renaissance for an extension before that date or the grant may be rescinded.
